

# MISSOURI VIDEO LOTTERY REGULATORY ACT

**Same Regulation. Same Oversight.  
Same Standards as Missouri Casinos.**

## LICENSING & BACKGROUND CHECKS

Manufacturers, distributors, operators, retailers, and handlers must be licensed by Missouri Lottery and pass mandatory background checks.

## GAME TESTING & FAIRNESS

VLTs must be certified by independent labs and meet technical standards for fairness and randomness.

## CENTRALIZED MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT

All VLTs connect to a central control system operated by the Missouri Lottery, allowing real-time monitoring and automatic shutdown for non-compliance.

## AGE RESTRICTIONS

Gambling limited to individuals 21 and older, in separated rooms from the general public.

## RESPONSIBLE GAMING PROTECTIONS

Mandatory self-exclusion, addiction warning signage, and consumer safeguards.

## CLEAR ENFORCEMENT & PENALTIES

Joint enforcement by the Missouri Lottery and Missouri Highway Patrol, with fines, license suspension, revocation for violations, and enforcement of illegal gambling.

## TAXATION, REPORTING, AND AUDITING

Gaming revenue is taxed, tracked, and audited through centralized reporting systems.

## What Missouri Casinos Don't Want You to Know...

***Regulated VLTs Operate Under Tighter Safeguards & Consumer Protections***

### HARD LIMITS CASINOS DON'T HAVE

Hard, system-enforced wager and payout caps set in statute.

### NO MARKERS. NO LINES OF CREDIT.

VLT regulation **prohibits gambling on credit** of any kind.

### NO CREDIT CARDS. NO CASH ADVANCES.

VLTs are **cash-only**. Players cannot use credit cards to gamble.
